The workshop was designed to enhance the academic writing skills of researchers, with both physical and online participants in attendance. He also provided valuable insights into the journal selection process, emphasizing the importance of targeting reputable, high-impact journals for wider visibility and academic recognition. In recognition of his valuable contribution, a token of appreciation was presented to Dr. Junaid Shaikh by the Vice Chancellor of FUUAST, Professor Dr. Zabta Khan Shinwari, who commended the initiative and encouraged continued academic development. Dr. Hina Mudassir announced that this workshop is part of a continuing series of capacity-building sessions aimed at strengthening research output at the university.
